

COLONEL JOHN G. MASTERS

Colonel John G. Masters is mobilization assistant to the director of contracting, Headquarters Air Force Materiel Command, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. He assists the Command's senior contracting officer with the management of a \$31 billion annual contracting mission with approximately 447,000 contracting actions.

He is also the advisor on all matters pertaining to assigned individual mobilization augmentees, and maintains oversight of the Reserve program to assure reservists add value to their peacetime organizations while they are gaining and maintaining wartime skills.

Colonel Masters was commissioned through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps program and entered active duty in September 1971. He has served in a broad range of acquisition related positions including logistics, contracting, and management.



In his civilian capacity, he is chief executive officer of Designers Midwest, a contracting and consulting engineering company located in Ohio.
