

## MAJOR GENERAL ROBERT J. WINNER

Major General Robert (Hank) Winner is mobilization assistant to the inspector general, Office of the Secretary of the Air Force, Washington, D.C. He assists in overseeing Air Force inspection policy; criminal investigations; counter-intelligence operations; complaints and fraud, waste and abuse programs; intelligence oversight; and two field operating agencies - the Air Force Inspection Agency and the Air Force Office of Special Investigations. Additionally, he serves as the chairman of the Air Force Reserve Advisory Board.



The general entered the Air Force in 1963, and was commissioned through Officer Training School, Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, as a distinguished graduate. A master navigator with more than 9,500 flying hours, General Winner has commanded an air reserve base and tactical airlift group, and three airlift wings, including the 302nd Airlift Wing during its Operation Desert Storm activation. His flying time has been principally in transport aircraft. He also served two tours as inspector general for the U.S. Air Force Reserve.
