MAJOR GENERAL GRANT R. MULDER

Major General Grant R. Mulder is mobilization assistant to the director for logistics, U.S. Atlantic Command (USACOM), Norfolk, Va. He oversees joint logistics plans, policies, procedures, operations, training and exercises in support of United States national security interests within the USACOM area of responsibility and in support of USACOM's role as the integrator, trainer and provider of joint forces to the unified commands worldwide.



The general entered the Air Force in 1963 and was commissioned through Officer Training School in March 1964. He flew the B-52H at Grand Forks Air Force Base, N.D. and the C-130A/H at Tachikawa Air Base, Japan; Lockborne Air Force Base, Ohio; and O'Hare Air Reserve Forces Facility, Chicago. He has been chief of standardization evaluation, squadron commander; group commander and mobilization assistant to the director of operations, Pacific Command, Camp Smith, Hawaii. He also was mobilization assistant to the commander, Air Force Inspection Agency, Kirtland Air Force Base, N.M. He is a command pilot with more than 5,000 hours mainly in multi-engined aircraft. While serving in the Far East he flew 700 combat hours in Vietnam.
