SUBJECT: Air Force Reserve Selected Reserve Line and Health Professions Major Selective Continuation Boards, 24-29 June 2002

The Chief of the Air Force Reserve (USAFR) has requested approval from the Secretary of the Air Force to convene selective continuation boards at the conclusion of the FY03 USAFR Selected Reserve (SELRES) Line and Health Professions Lieutenant Colonel Promotion Selection Board, 24-29 June 2002.

The selective continuation boards will consider USAFR Line and Health professions majors who are on the Reserve Active Status List (RASL) and assigned to the SELRES or who are limited extended active duty (LEAD) officers serving with the active component of the USAF for periods of 3 years or less as of the board convening date. The boards will consider all twice-deferred, SELRES or former Air Force Reserve LEAD line and health professions majors who fail promotion selection to lieutenant colonel for two or more times and are required to be removed from an active status due to their promotion non-selections. Selected majors may not be continued beyond the last day of the month in which they complete 24 years of total federal commissioned service. No officer will be continued beyond the last day of the month in which that officer becomes 60 years of age. Continued majors will be eligible for promotion consideration for as long as they remain on the RASL.

Attachment 1 lists those majors that are currently once or more deferred. These officers are eligible for selective continuation only if twice or more deferred for promotion. This does not imply non-selection, but affords the member an opportunity for continuation if non-selected by the 24-29 June 2002 promotion selection boards.

Recent change to Section 14701A of Title 10 U.S.C. terminates the requirement that a reserve officer apply for continuation on the RASL. This will afford all eligible officers consideration by the continuation boards without requiring advanced application for consideration. The officer still retains the option to accept or decline continuation if offered.

Request MPFs/DPMs contact commanders of eligible officers and advise them that they must submit a package IAW AFI 36-2504, paragraph 10.3.2 if they feel any of their officers are not qualified for continuation. Packages must be received prior to the board.

MPFs/DPMs must contact eligible officers and advise them of their option to write a letter to the board IAW AFI 36-2504, paragraph 4.7. If an officer chooses to write a letter to the board it

must be addressed as follows: Board President, Selective Continuation Boards. Letters should be mailed to the following address and must be received NLT 24 June 2002:

In addition, MPFs/DPMs must advise officers writing a letter to the board to keep the following in mind: Letter must include signature with SSN; not attach anything that may become or is already a part of their selection folder, for example a draft OPR that is still being processed; not include anything in the letter that is masked for their promotion board (this includes references to PME above the level of ISS, or equivalent for majors), and not have anyone write a letter on their behalf.

The selective continuation board will consider officers' qualifications and potential for continuation based on their selection folder. Officers selected for continuation will be notified and given the opportunity to accept or decline.

The codes listed in the PC (promotion category) column on the eligibility lists are defined as follows:

A – Line	N – Nurse Corps
D – Dental Corps	S – Medical Service Corps
M – Medical Corps	W – Biomedical Science Corps
